

NRA Gun Safety Rules

- ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.
- Know your target and what is beyond it.
- Know how to use the firearm safely.
- Be sure the firearm is safe to operate.
- Use only the correct ammunition for your firearm.
- Wear eye and ear protection as appropriate.
 - Eye and Ear protection must be warn upon entering the range and at all times in the range.
- Never use alcohol, prescription, or over the counter drugs before or while shooting.
 - Any substance likely to impair normal mental or physical bodily functions, must not be used before or while handling or shooting guns.
- Store guns so they are not accessible to unauthorized persons.
- Be aware that certain types of firearms and shooting activities require additional safety precautions.
- Anyone can call a Ceasefire. If you hear someone call out Ceasefire please immediately place your firearm down on the bench and step back from the firing line.
 Await further instruction from the RSO.
 - In case of Emergency or a power outage, treat as if a ceasefire command was given.

Elite Indoor Shooting Range – Site Specific Range Rules

- Follow the instructions and commands of the Range Safety Officers and other Elite Range Staff at all times. Any deviation of the range rules must be approved by the range safety officer or employee before the deviation.
 - The range safety officer on duty is in direct charge of the range and all participants.
 - If asked to leave the range by an RSO please do so and if you feel it was unwarranted please bring it up to a manager who will review the case with the Chief Range Safety Officer.
- All shooters are expected to know and adhere to the range rules. If you observe a violation to the range rules please bring it to the attention of an RSO.
- Elite reserves the right to deny service to anyone, at any time, for any reason.
- All Federal, State, and Local firearm laws must be obeyed.



- No food, beverages, smoking, or tobacco products are allowed in the ranges.
- RSOs have the right to inspect all firearms, ammunition, and equipment.
- Proper dress is required.
 - No open toed shoes.
- No cross lane firing Fire only at targets in your lane.
- Please feel free to privately disclose any necessary medical information to an RSO which you
 feel could pose a safety hazard to yourself or another. (Epilepsy, Hearing Impaired, Diabetes)
 While this is not required it may help in the event of a medical emergency. Always wash your
 hands after shooting. Facilities and supplies will be available to do so.
- If you sustain an injury, minor or major inform an RSO who will assist you.
 - Cover any open cuts prior to entering the range.
- Only handle firearms on the firing line.
- If you have a malfunction wait 30 seconds before clearing your firearm.
 - If you believe you may have had a squib load run a range flag down the barrel to check for an obstruction.
 - If you are unsure how to clear your malfunction keep the firearm pointed down range, raise your non-dominant hand and wait for the assistance of an RSO.
- No drawing from a holster until you have passed the holster class and are approved to do so.
 - Your approval badge must be displayed at all times while utilizing a holster.
 - No shoulder holsters, cross draw, or ankle holsters.
 - The RSO has the authority to stop anyone from using a holster they feel is unsafe even if previously approved.
- You must remain in control of your firearm at all times while firing. No un-aimed or uncontrollable fire. You assume responsibility for any damage that you cause to the facility.
 - Shooters may be limited to firing one shot per second if they are unable to shoot at a rate of fire which they can safely and accurately keep rounds on target.
 - Binary Triggers and Slide fire requires special approval.
- Pregnancy Health official's advice limiting exposure to lead. While it is not prohibited we do
 not take responsibility or liability and recommend against it. We recommend consulting your
 physician.
- Only two people allowed per lane. Only one person shooting at a time.



- Only one loaded firearm at a time. All other firearms should be pointed downrange with a chamber flag in the action.
- Only two firearms on the bench at a time.
- Firearms must be cased to switch lanes. If you don't want to case them up the shooters can swap lanes, but the firearms remain on the bench.
- Do not bring a loaded or malfunctioning firearms off the range. Notify the RSO and await instructions.
- Brass may be retrieved behind the firing line. Throw unwanted brass in the proper bins and push the rest forward when finished shooting.
- Elite is not responsible for any lost or stolen personal items or equipment left unattended
- Paper targets only.
 - Use appropriately sized target for your distance, at a height that your shots strike the backstop, not the floor, ceiling, or target carrier.
 - No photos of real people.
 - We reserve the right to prohibit any targets we deem offensive.
 - Targets must be no closer than 3 yards.
- Be aware of other shooters and your surroundings.
- No steel core ammo, armor piercing, or tracer.
 - Shotguns are limited to 00 buck and slugs.

Elite Indoor Shooting Range – Gun Rental Policies

- Ammo used in rental guns must be purchased from Elite Indoor Ranges.
- You must be 21 to rent a handgun.

Minor Policy

- Minors under the age of 18 must initially be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian, who must sign a separate Minor Waiver Form.
 - Thereafter the minor must be accompanied by an adult.
- Minors will be restricted in caliber and firearm type based on the discretion of the RSO.
- Minors under the age of 18 will be limited to .22 caliber pistols and rifles, until proficiency is demonstrated. At which time an RSO can approve larger calibers which he believes the minor can safely handle.
